This TEMPUS project was submitted in the (TEMPUS IV-Sixth call for proposals) by March 2013. Number of submitted proposals was 973, where only 170 projects were selected for funding.

Our TEMPUS project has the title (Capacity Building of Personnel in Jordanian Olive Industry).

## **Objectives of the Project**

The project aims to develop the Jordanian olive sector, which is important for the Jordanian economy. This goal will be achieved through the cooperation between UJ and EU as well as other Jordanian partners.

This project focuses on capacity building of Jordanian olive farmers, olive mills and the table olive personnel, and olive sensory evaluation teams so as to improve the quality of the Jordanian table olives and olive oil to comply with the IOC standards
