Prof. Salman Ajib, OWL-UAS, presented the tasks and activities of this work package and the action plan for the implementation. The steps and time frame to prepare the needed teaching material were presented.

Groups were formed from participants according to their field of specialty to discuss the outline of different courses in Energy, Water, and Environment. Parallel sessions were dedicated to present, discuss, and finalize the courses outlines. Among the 14 courses in environmental engineering and climate change, two of them will be elaborated in e-learning courses, also ECTS will be taken into consideration for these courses.

Partners will be responsible to adapt at least 7 courses in their curriculum and follow the needed internal accreditation steps. They will responsible to provide the coordinator by a letter indicating the approval to include these selected courses in their curriculum.

Also, the lab equipment list was identified for each Jordanian and Syrian partner universities and authorization from EACEA was obtained.
