

Water Energy nexus Conference 4-5/11/2019

The university of Jordan held The National Conference on “Water Energy Nexus” under the patronage of the Prime Minister of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, H.E. Dr. Omar Al-Razzaz, during November 4-5, 2019 in Hilton Dead Sea Resort –Jordan.

The purpose of the Conference was to strengthen the dialogue between water and energy sectors in Jordan and facilitate the exchange of international and regional knowledge, experiences and best practices in the context of the water-energy nexus, particularly aspects related to renewable energy (RE), energy efficiency (EE) and Climate Change

The 129 workshop registered participants represented more than 35 entities, including governments, Parliament council, Senate council, universities, companies, funding agencies, associations, media and non-governmental organizations. Among the participants, there were the Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources, the Minister of Water and Irrigation, President of the university of Jordan, the senator Prof. Rida Khawaldeh, and the Parliament council member (Eng. Jamal Qamoh). In addition; the representative of the German ambassador, general secretaries from the ministries, and deans of different faculties were also in the conference.

This conference conduct in 4-5 November 2019, divided to four sessions, every session includes presentations and discussion panel in different topics concerning the water & energy. Prof. Ahmed Al-Salaymeh, the coordinator of EGREEN, was the chairman of organizing committee for the conference Also
