

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Developing a Multidisciplinary Diploma on Art Therapy in Health Education



HEALING project will be designed and implemented across (3) Universities in Tunisia, (5) Universities in Jordan, and (6) Universities across Europe (Italy, Portugal, Greece, Belgium, Croatia).

The main objective of the Healing project is to divulge and foster the development of the Arts Therapies and Arts Therapies education in Tunisia and Jordan, exploiting the know-how of partner countries.
