
On **December 17th, 2020**, The University of Jordan held the Sixth Online Management Meeting for “HEALING” project.

During the meeting, Work package leaders presented the progress in seven work packages of HEALING Project (WP1, WP2, WP3, WP4, WP5, WP6 and WP7). Also they pointed out what is required from partners.

The meeting was attended by **32** persons from the partner universities in Jordan, Tunisia, Portugal, Croatia, Italy, Belgium and Greece.

- d) Occupational Profiles of Graduates**
Students who will graduate from the program can apply to various institutions (e.g., rehabilitation centres; hospitals; schools; prisons and other correctional facilities; community mental health centres; seniors' centres and nursing homes; daycare centres; counselling centres and clinics) as creative arts therapist; music therapist; drama therapist; dance therapist; and occupational therapist.
- e) Courses Organization**
Courses will start at the beginning of the Academic year and will last two semesters. Each student will have to take 12 courses, eight obligatory, and four elective courses (chosen among ten alternatives). In addition, to promote ethical and practical skills relevant to become art therapists, students will have to complete a one-year-internship experience in the clinical or community settings.
- f) Graduation Requirements**
Students will earn the Diploma upon completion of the final examination consisting of 100 multiple-choice questions. Eighty questions will be related to the Core Courses topics, twenty to the topics of the elective courses. In addition, students will have to present their project with 45' PowerPoint presentation. In order for each student to be graduated, all of the following requirements must be fulfilled:
 - The students must successfully complete courses covering at least XX national credits and XX ECTS credits, corresponding to 80% of the lessons.
 - The students should score at least 60/100 at the final examination
 - The ad hoc dissertation committee must approve students' presentations.
