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INTRODUCTION

The main objective of the ICT4EDU project is to improve the quality of ICT competencies of early childhood teacher's educators in nine higher education institutions in Jordan, Palestine and Egypt in line with the advanced EU practices and thereby increase the quality of education in preschools in Jordan, Palestine and Egypt. With ICT playing a major role in facilitating the education of children with special needs or disabilities, the ICT4EDU project seeks to ensure that recently graduated student teachers are capable of instructing using ICT and to enhance the digital literacy of both teachers and students.

This report will summarize the workshops activities organized in MENA universities.

NATIONAL WORKSHOPS

Description

National Training Workshop were held in the context of the ICT4EDU project, aimed at integrating Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) into Early Childhood Education (ECE) programs across higher education institutions in Jordan, Palestine, and Egypt. There were three National workshops, with the aim of informing and analysing the progresses made in each university regarding the curricula update.

Bringing together educators, students, curriculum developers, policymakers, and other stakeholders, the workshops focused on critically evaluating the recent curriculum updates and strategizing on effective dissemination methods. The goal was to enhance the quality of ECE by incorporating advanced digital competences and ICT tools, in line with contemporary educational standards and the specific needs of the MENA region.

The University of Bucharest, the leader of the WP 3 participated in the workshops organized in Egypt and Palestine.

Organization period

The Egypt National Workshop was the first National Workshop and was held on February 12, 2024, strategically organized close to the Cairo project meeting on February 13-14. The Palestine National Workshop took place on May 16, 2024, conducted online due to current circumstances. The Jordan National Workshop was organized on May 29, 2024, at the University of Jordan's School of Information Technology, with both physical and online participation options.

Participation

In Egypt, the workshop brought together representatives from Al-Azhar University – the organizer of the workshop, Suez Canal University, and Heliopolis University, along with members from MENA countries and EU partner universities. Online participation further increased visibility and attendance. The Palestine workshop, conducted via Zoom and organized by Palestine Technical University - Kadoorie, engaged 54 participants, including the President of PTUK and the ICT4EDU

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project coordinator. In Jordan, the workshop organized by University of Jordan at the UJ's School of Information Technology involved 33 online participants and 13 physical attendees, including Jordanian and non-Jordanian partners and stakeholders.

Main Discussions and Findings

In Egypt, the primary focus was on presenting and discussing courses selected for updates or development, with an emphasis on integrating ICT components into their content and delivery methods. Each university presented their selected courses, proposed updates, and the responsible teams. This collaborative effort aimed to enhance the quality of education by incorporating advanced digital skills and technologies into the curricula.

The interactive session provided a platform for staff members, students, and other stakeholders to offer feedback and suggestions, ensuring the revisions met the needs of all parties involved. The presence of students and teachers from Al Azhar University was crucial in voicing the beneficiaries' needs, contributing significantly to the project outputs. Supporting materials documented and promoted the event.

In Palestine, the workshop focused on disseminating and exploiting the ICT4EDU project outcomes, particularly integrating ICT in Early Childhood Education (ECE) programs. Discussions emphasized the importance of using ICT to enhance education quality and the competencies of early childhood teachers, with a special focus on digital literacy for educators and students, including those with special needs, promoting inclusivity, reaffirming commitment to achieve excellence through innovative methods, aligning with the broader objectives of the ICT4EDU project. Key speakers highlighted PTUK's strategic goal of achieving excellence through innovative development methods and the significant impact of ICT in modernizing teaching methods and improving educational outcomes. Effective dissemination strategies ensured widespread communication of the workshop's objectives and outcomes.

In Jordan, discussions were organized around updating and improving courses to meet Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and ICT integration. Each university presented its courses and discussions were organized as well discussions with stakeholders for feedback, fostering a collaborative environment for refining the educational updates. The primary objective of this workshop is to ensure that the educational foundations laid for students are robust and adaptive to recent advancements in the learning process. Teachers, being pivotal in implementing these changes, are central to the discussions and outcomes of this workshop.

Key topics included making the Social Media course mandatory, encouraging male enrollment in the Class Teacher course, and incorporating more activities in the courses. The courses were designed with multidisciplinary components and emphasized learner-centered teaching strategies such as case studies, simulations, games, discussions, and project-based learning. The event highlighted the integration of ICT, Education for Sustainable Development (ESD), and SDGs in the newly developed courses, ensuring alignment between learning outcomes, content, assignments, and evaluations.

CONCLUSIONS

The National Workshops under the ICT4EDU project were effective in advancing the integration of ICT into Early Childhood Education curricula in the MENA region. They successfully engaged stakeholders, addressed regional educational needs, and aligned with broader educational goals. Moving forward, enhancing online participation, focusing on inclusivity, and monitoring long-term impacts will be crucial for sustaining the project's success.


Event Description




PTUK organized the national workshop for Palestinian universities participating in the ICT4EDU project via the Zoom platform, with the participation of the President of Palestine Technical University - Kadoorie Prof. Dr. Hussein Shank, President of Al-Istiqlal University, Prof. Dr. Nour al-Din Abu al-Rub and Dean of Palestine Technical College - Deir al-Balah, represented by Dr. Ezzaldeen Edwan and the Director of the Erasmus Office in Palestine, Prof. Dr. Abdul Karim Daraghme and the project coordinator from the University of Jordan, Prof. Dr. Ahmed Al-Salaymeh.

In this context, Prof. Dr. Hussein Shank mentioned that as per PTUK strategy, the university seeks to achieve excellence at the local and international levels by adopting various means of development in various aspects, indicating the importance of serious and distinguished teamwork to move forward in Palestinian universities through joint work to occupy a prominent position and enjoy a good reputation locally and at global level. 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Event Description

The University of Jordan (UJ) has organized the Jordan National Workshop in partnership with Mutah University (MU) and Irbid National University (INU). UJ organized the national workshop for the Jordanian universities participating in the ICT4EDU project at the School of Information Technology at the University of Jordan and it was also broadcasted online on ZOOM, with the participation of Jordanian partners, non-Jordanian project partners and some stakeholders.

In the workshop, partners from UJ, MU and INU presented their updated courses, The development process of each course included a careful review of each course syllabus and updating course objectives to meet SDGs. Examples of the highlighted SDGs were: insuring inclusive and equitable quality education (SDG4), promoting peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development (SDG 16), and creating inclusive societies (SDG 5). Furthermore, to achieve the ICT4EDU objectives, the developed courses were designed with multidisciplinary components and ESD competences.

In conclusion, ICT, ESD, and SDGs were all included in the UJ-developed courses. There is one learning assignment and a relevant bibliography for each unit. In each developed course there was an alignment between learning outcomes, content, learning assignments and final evaluation. The developed courses implemented a wide range of learner-centered teaching strategies related to interdisciplinary approach and real-life, including case studies, simulation, games, discussions, and project-based learning.

The updated courses were discussed with the partners and feedback was collected. The main points discussed are:

- The possibility of making the Social Media course mandatory instead of an Elective.
- Making a description of the Social Media course to encourage students to take this important course.
- Encouraging enrolling males in the Class Teacher course since it was mentioned that only females take it.
- Including more activities in the courses.




