The GREEN project is looking for an **External Evaluator** for the duration of the project (01/02/2026 – 31/12/2027). The evaluator will provide an independent assessment of the project's implementation, outcomes, and quality assurance mechanisms.

Project Overview:

GREEN aims to develop a vocational diploma in green hydrogen technologies by fostering collaboration between higher education institutions (HEIs) and industry partners. The project includes designing accredited courses, building academic capacity, and aligning curricula with modern European strategies in green energy education.

Evaluator Role:

The external evaluator will assess progress toward project objectives, contribute to EU-standard implementation, and evaluate the robustness of the project's quality assurance processes. Tasks include the preparation of **two evaluation reports** (intermediate and final), peer review of key deliverables, and analysis of project surveys and questionnaires.

Selection Criteria:

- A Master's degree or preferably PhD
- At least 3 years' experience in evaluating international educational projects
- Proven expertise in both qualitative and quantitative evaluation methods
- Strong communication and reporting skills in English
- Relevant EU project evaluation or advisory experience preferred

Deliverables and Timeline:

- **Intermediate Report:** Due 30/06/2026
- **Final Report:** Due 31/12/2027
