## Second Steering Committee Meeting in Höxter

The Second steering committee meeting for EGREEN Project was held on September 13-15, 2017 in Höxter-Germany. It was hosted by Ostwestfalen-Lippe University of Applied Sciences (OWL UAS) and attended by 32 representatives from different project partners including Jordan, Syria, Portugal, Austria, and Germany.



The meeting was attended by Prof. Dr. Jürgen Krahl, the President of Ostwestfalen-Lippe University of Applied Sciences; Prof. Prof. Hani Shaaban, Tishreen University President and Representatives of partner organizations from Jordan, Syria and Europe were also at the meeting.



The Steering Committee discussed the status and the work plan of the project activities. The meeting focused on the discussion and presentation of the tasks and activities of the work packages, also on the action plan for their implementation. A course was suggested for each theme, committees responsible for the courses development was formed.



The Steering Committee discussed Preparing the training program for the planned workshops targeting faculty members and technical assistants after consultations with EU partners.
