Two-week training workshop for students was held in Ostwestfalen-Lippe University of Applied Sciences - Höxter in Germany, during July 1-12, 2019. The main purpose of the workshop is to allow students to do experimental investigations in the laboratory in the field of energy engineering and get introduction on the wastewater and efficiency, management meteorology and environmental monitoring systems, and thermographic sensors with drones.
