Tihana Škojo was born in Osijek in 1975. She graduated Music Education from the Faculty of Pedagogy in Osijek. Due to her remarkable success during her studies, she was awarded two of Rector's Awards and the Scholarship for gifted students provided by the Croatian Ministry of Science and Technology.

In 2010, she obtained a Postgraduate Masters degree in Musical Pedagogy (academic level – Master, area of Social Sciences, Field of Pedagogy, branch Special Pedagogy) at an inter-faculty study programme between the Academy of Music and Department of Pedagogy of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Zagreb, with the thesis titled *Synchronic Model of Music Education Teaching and Its Comparison to the Diachronic Model*.

In 2015, she obtained a PhD degree at the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Zagreb by defending the thesis *Didactic and Methodological Structuring of Music Curriculum in General and Compulsory Education*. She was a member of the expert workgroup for the Curriculum development of Music Culture and Music Art as part of the Comprehensive Curricular Reform.
