







CONTEXT

QUESTIONNAIRE - OUTCOME



- Needed to establish a vocational training center in each university to deliver different workshops and training on skills and competencies
- Low level of training for graduate and undergraduate students where the percentage of workshops taken by students during their study at their university was around 35% only
- Weak role of the university in offering interesting training programs.
- The companies' surveys showed that the new graduate students have some deficiencies in the vocational skills and competencies.






